



## Fed up refuelling your woodburner?

It may be possible to burn both solid fuel and wood on your appliance. The installation of a multifuel grate\* could make this possible.


The frequency of refuelling and the quantity of wood needed to maintain adequate heat output can be underestimated by newcomers to wood burning.
